#### School absences

#### Reminders

#### Bikes and Scooters (Wheels) - Safety

Our students were reminded today to walk their bikes and scooters into and out of the school at the beginning and end of the day. This includes younger siblings and adults.

#### Playgrounds - Safety

Our Senior Playground is for students aged 7 and over with the Junior Playground for those aged 7 and under allowed at any time. Students who are aged over 7 are allowed on the Junior playground as long as they are playing with someone who is under 7.

#### Lost Property

We are working with our students on the value of Responsibility / Haepapa - in particular for their clothing. If an item of clothing is left in the playground, it will remain there so the owner can remember and reclaim it from where it was last worn. 
