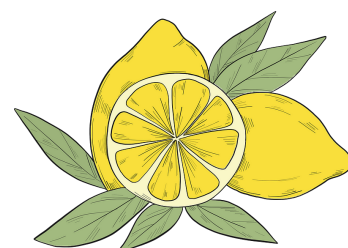
BREAKFAST CLUB

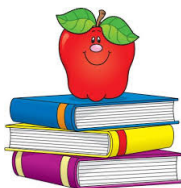
