We have talked about Tawhirimatea (and the impact of our weather) who can often show us their power - this was very clear this week.

There has also been discussion in many classes about the earthquakes that struck southern Turkey and Syria. We have connections with Turkey through our school and our thoughts are with the people of Turkey and Syria as they seek to put their lives back together after this catastrophic event.
