Talofa Lava,

This week we celebrated Samoan Language Week. Thank you to our teachers and students who have been learning greetings, phrases and counting in Samoan as well as songs and sasa. I would like to thank Dontae and Leilah who have visited many classes and worked alongside the teacher. Here is some of the language they explored:

Talofa Lava - Hello

O ā mai 'oe - how are you?

Manuia fa'afetai - I am good thank you.

Many of our students are able to count using: Tasi, lua, tolu, fa, lima, ono, fitu, valu, iva, sefulu.

Resilience / Manawaroa

We are really pleased with the resilience of our students with the changeable weather this week. They have had to adapt quickly during their break times between outside and inside activities. Our teachers have supported them really well to make responsible / haepapa choices when it is time to change our play from outside to inside.

Covid Organisation

We have had 14 positive COVID cases this term with three of these people being staff members. 12 people have been in isolation and two of these have become positive cases. We have spoken with 10 of our local schools about their COVID organisation to help us make decisions for our school for the next two weeks. We will continue to wear masks for Years 4 - 6 students (unless they have an exemption) and ask that you wear a mask (unless you have an exemption) and keep to the asphalt or grass areas when you need to come onsite. Our assemblies will continue to be held online and we have some internal organisation where we will start to relax and use areas of the school that we haven't currently been in.


