Covid Organisation

This term we have had 17 people who have had COVID or been required to isolate, 14 are students and 3 are staff. We had a spike of winter illnesses at the start of the term and these have eased as the term has gone on.

We thank everyone for supporting us with our organisation and expectations with our practices for the first four weeks of this term - following the Ministry of Education's strong recommendations.

We have considered our organisation at Orange Level and as of Monday 29 August 2022 we will:

- Continue with mask wearing for staff members and year 4 to 6 students, whilst offering the option to not wear a mask inside. Outside optional mask wearing will continue for staff and students.
- We ask visitors and our community who come onsite to keep wearing masks.
 (Obviously, if you and/or your children have a mask exemption we do not expect you to be wearing a mask).
- We continue to welcome our community onsite and ask you to keep out of classrooms and off the decks (please keep to asphalt and grass areas for drop off and pick up).
- We will hold assemblies in the hall with students and staff only from week 8. We will film these and share a link with you via email.

Note: If we have an increase in COVID cases or concerns in regards to illnesses and new variants in our community we will reconsider our organisation without hesitation and inform you of any changes.

We will review this organisation in Week 9 of this term.

We thank you for your continued support with our COVID organisation.


ONESIE (and PJ) Day- Friday 2nd September
