Volume of our Values Reward!

Our students have been living by our values of Whakaute / Respect, Haepapa / Responsibility, Manawaroa / Resilience, and Auahatanga / Creativity and this is recognised with our tokens. We are pleased to announce that we have reached the silver level of the volume of our values and we have voted on our celebratory reward.

Next Wednesday (6th July) we are going to have a Dress-up Day! The theme is Characters. Children can come to school dressed as any character they wish or they might come as someone/thing that could be considered as a bit of a 'character'!

Covid Organisation

This term we have had 22 people who have had COVID, 19 are students and 3 are staff. Compared with Term 1, we had 125 people with COVID, 115 were students and 10 staff. The lesser cases this term are a celebration for our community - we thank everyone for supporting us with our organisation and expectations with our COVID practices.

With this data in mind and consideration given to our organisation at Orange Level we have decided to do the following starting on Monday 4 July 2022:

- Continue with mask wearing for staff members and year 4 to 6 students, whilst offering the option to not wear a mask inside. Outside optional mask wearing will continue for staff and students.
- We ask visitors and our community who come onsite to keep wearing masks. (Obviously, if you and/or your children have a mask exemption we do not expect you to be wearing a mask).
- We invite our community back onsite and ask you to keep out of classrooms and off the decks (please keep to asphalt and grass areas for drop off and pick up).
- For our upcoming Whanau and Kaiako Hui, we ask that masks are worn for these meetings.

Note: If we have an increase in COVID cases or concerns in regards to new variants in our community we will reconsider our organisation without hesitation and inform you of any changes.

We will review this organisation during the July term break and inform you of any changes on Thursday 21 July for Term 3.

We thank you for your continued support with our COVID organisation.
