She taught us interesting facts about our native bird, but also explained the different ways that people can be kaitiaki / guardians for kiwi. It was a fascinating talk for all, and what impressed the teachers the most was how the tamariki made connections with their learning on animal habitats in our Term 2 concept of 'Thrive'. They were able to recall some of the big ideas from our trip to Wellington Zoo in June!

After the Kiwi Talk every Junior class, with our amazing parent helpers, packed their school bags for a trip to Te Awakairangi (Hutt River). After a morning tea on the stones, each class put on their special 'clean-up' gloves and made their way around the stony beach and riverbank picking up rubbish. 
