We are continuing to use Signmee to send out all notices. Please make sure you are able to access this and if you are having any issues, please contact Penny or Jo in the office.

Appointments/Lateness

If you need to pick up your child early or your child is late to school for any reason please sign in and out through the office. This is so that we all have a record of who is at school in case of an emergency.

Please remember we are unable to supervise children who are present before 8.30am, before school care is available in the hall.

Long Term Plan
